

# The Piecemakers - Quilt Along 2016

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## The Rocky Mountains

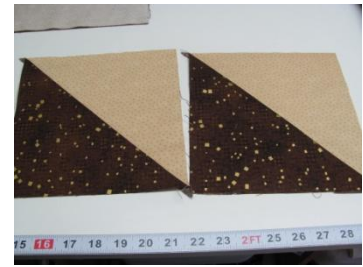
You will need:

four 8 1/2" squares of "sky" fabric

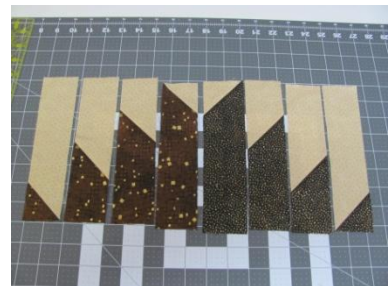
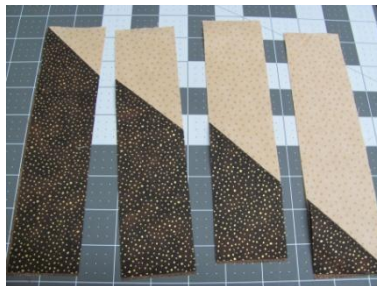
four 8 1/2" squares of "mountain" fabric



1. With right sides together, layer a square of sky fabric with a square of mountain fabric. Mark a diagonal line across the square. Sew a 1/4" on either side of the line. Cut on the original marked line. Press open.



2. Layer two half square triangle squares on top of each other, matching diagonal seam BUT having opposite colours right sides together. Cut pieced squares into 2" segments. Hint: be sure to always have the pieced square turned in the same direction with the sky fabric in the upper left corner and the mountain fabric in the lower right.



3. Arrange 2 x 8" strips and sew rows together to make the delectable mountains block. Sew together to make the Rocky Mountain Row.
