Quilt Registration Information

Thank you for submitting your quilt for display! The show is not a juried show. Ribbons will be awarded to 1st 2nd and 3rd for each quilt category voted by you, the members of the Westshore Guild. In addition, we will have a "Viewers Choice" vote by the general public. We have tried to make the registration process as easy as possible. We also need to make sure your quilt is safe and secure, so we do have to ask you to follow some procedures.

What to show:

1. All entries must be clean, constructed of fabric, quilted or tied, bound and finished. Quilts constructed for mass production i.e. wholesale or retail purchases cannot be displayed. **All quilts must come with a sleeve for hanging.** Instructions for how to attach a sleeve will be included in coming newsletters.
2. Quilts previously shown at a Westshore Quilters Guild Show may not be entered.
3. Quilts shown at other shows may be entered.
4. Please be aware that quilts will be on display and may be handled. We will have members asking guests not to handle the quilts except with the provided gloves or clothes pins.

Registration

1. A separate registration form is required for each entry. Entry forms are available in the newsletter, on the guild's website, and the guild's facebook page. They can be submitted via-e-mail: westshorequilts2017@gmail.com or brought to a meeting: February 2017 meeting being the latest. Marlene Speed is the contact for registrations.
2. **Photos are not required this year.**

3. Registration numbers and A/B tags will be emailed to each person. If you do not have access to a computer or email or if you do not own a printer please let Marlene Speed know and I will bring a hard copy to the next guild meeting.
4. Neither the Guild nor the Show Committee is responsible for damaged or lost claim tags and show entries. Insurance is the responsibility of the entrant.
5. Submission of a quilt to the Quilt Show constitutes permission by the quilter/owner to allow it to be photographed by the show committee, show attendees and the media
6. Every attempt will be made to display quilts to their best advantage. In the event of limited venue options the displays are at the discretion of the display committee.

Drop off will be on Thursday March 30th , time to be disclosed later. Pick up no later than 6 pm on Saturday April 1.
